Prof. Johanna Hey is one of the most respected authorities on Tax Law in Germany. She is head of Institute for Tax Law at the University of Cologne and belongs to several committees, including the Scientific Advisory Board of the Federal Ministry of Finance.

Since the winter term 2002/2003, she has led the chair of corporate law at the Heinrich Heine University in Düsseldorf. In October 2006, she became director of the Institute of Tax Law at the University of Cologne.

From 2004 to 2012, Johanna was a member of the committee and first VP of the German Association of University Professors. Since 2006, she has been a member of the Scientific Advisory Board of the Federal Ministry of Finance. In 2010, she was announced scientific head of the Berlin Finance and Taxation Institute and, in the same year, was elected into the Permanent Deputation of the Association of German Jurists. From 2011 to 2016, she was head of the Scientific Advisory Board of German Tax Lawyers. Since 2011 Johanna Hey has been a member of the Scientific Advisory Board of the Centre for European Economic Research (ZEW).
